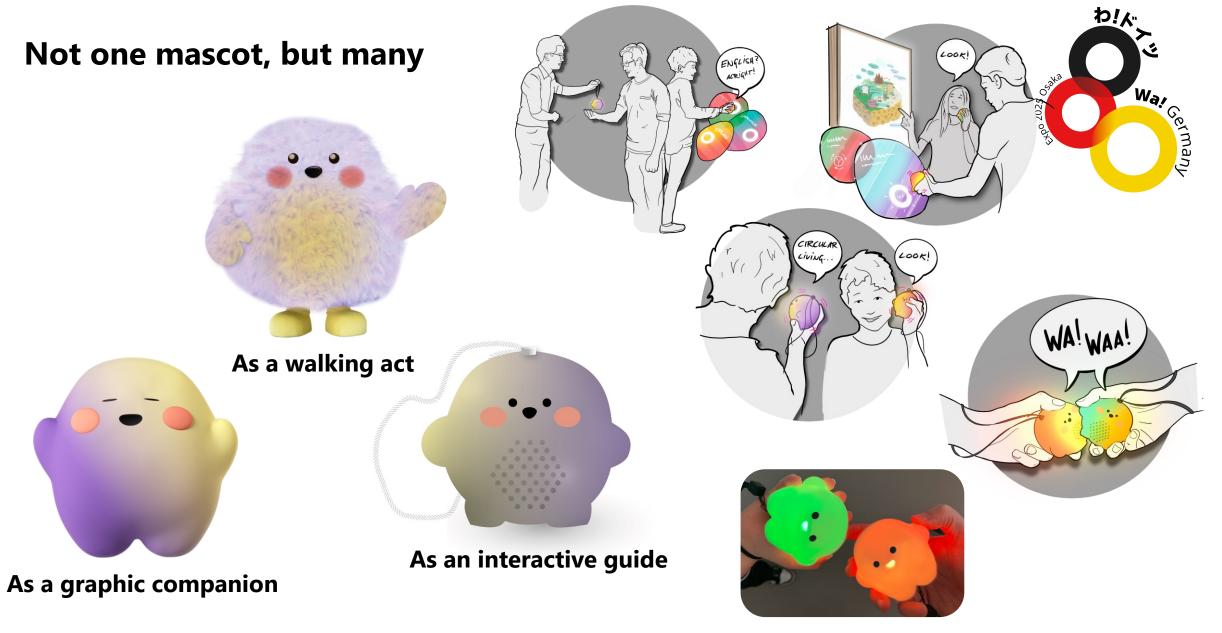

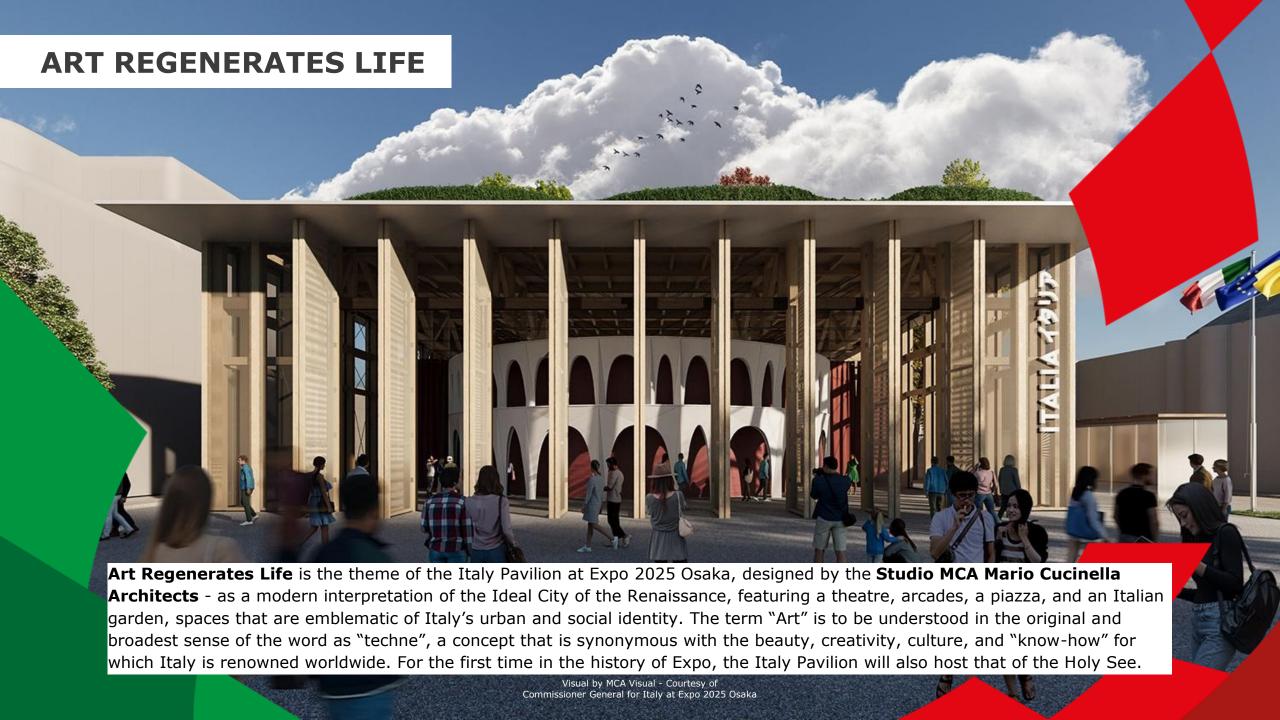








ITALY PAVILION



AREAS OF THE ITALY PAVILION

THEATRE

Theatre – The space that welcomes the visitor into an immersive story, introducing them to a real experience inside the Pavilion. Every night, the theatre becomes a lively scenery, where Italian musical talents, ranging from singing to entertainment and performative arts, will have a stage to perform.

TERRITORY

The space dedicated to the Territory will host 18 Italian Regions which will represent the Italy Pavilion every week. Ranging from local traditions to the main areas of cultural and immaterial heritage, from culinary, artisanal, industrial and technological treasures to universities, research art and music, every Region will present concrete expressions of the Italian lifestyle.

US

The space dedicated to "US" will talk about society, focusing on the main infrastructures and social projects that our country will realize over the following years. This section will host design, architecture and engineering projects linked to the territory and the main sports events.

PIAZZA

It is the heart of the Italy Pavilion, a symbolic place of relationship, exchange and encounter. At the center stands the great marble statue of the Farnese Atlas – original work from the II century, 2 meters of height, representing the Atlas carrying the celestial globe over his shoulders, signalling the crossing point of the entire Pavilion, between the exhibition areas of the "I" (the individual), "Us" (the society), "Territory" and "Spirituality", the section dedicated to the Holy See.

IO

The space dedicated to the "I", the individual, talks about wellness in a society that gets older and older, to imagine a better present and future. Through innovative projects that link contemporary art settings to science and technology on health and environmental topics as interdependent elements. The goal is to raise awareness on the use of artificial intelligence, domotics and robotics as means to offer new solutions for a future that brings value to the individual in harmony with the environment.

AREAS OF THE ITALY PAVILION

ITALIAN GARDEN

Italian Garden -visible from the Grand Ring, symbol of EXPO, the ceiling of the Italian Pavilion is characterized by an Italian Garden, decorated with sculptures, fountains and green spaces designed by artists and engineers to offer a moment of relax and enjoy moments of conviviality with Italian food and drinks in the anterior restaurant.

SPIRITUALITY

The space dedicated to Spirituality in the Italian Pavilion is represented for the first time in Expo history by the Holy See. In the middle of this space there will be Caravaggio's work of art "La Deposizione di Cristo". The painting, positioned 30 cm from the ground, will be admired at human height.

PORTICO

Portico – The Portico: located in the front part of the Pavilion, it surrounds the space of the theatre and will host artisans from all the Italian regions, who will show their know-how, their products and tools with live demonstrations of the manufacturing.

RESTAURANT

The space dedicated to Spirituality in the Italian Pavilion is represented for the first time in Expo history by the Holy See. In the middle of this space there will be Caravaggio's work of art "La Deposizione di Cristo". The painting, positioned 30 cm from the ground, will be admired at human height.



FARNESE ATLAS

"Art Regenerates Life" is the theme of the Italy Pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka, designed by architect Mario Cucinella, MCA - Mario Cucinella Architects - as a modern interpretation of the Ideal City of the Renaissance, featuring a theatre, arcades, a piazza, and an Italian garden, spaces that are emblematic of Italy's urban and social identity.

The term "Art" is to be understood in the original and broadest sense of the word as "techne", a concept that is synonymous with the beauty, creativity, culture, and "knowhow" for which Italy is renowned worldwide. For the first time in the history of Expo, the Italy Pavilion will also host that of the Holy See.



FARNESE ATLAS

For the first time in Asia

Symbol of travel, discovery, research,
and science

The **2nd-century original** marble masterpiece weighing 2,000 kilograms and standing 2 metres tall from the collection of the **National Archaeological Museum of Naples (MANN)**.

CARAVAGGIO'S "THE ENTOMBMENT OF CHRIST" 1604

The Holy See, hosted for the first time in Expo history with a dedicated section in the Italy Pavilion, will exhibit "La Deposizione" by Caravaggio" (1604). This extraordinary work will be admired at near proximity, standing just 30 centimetres from the ground.



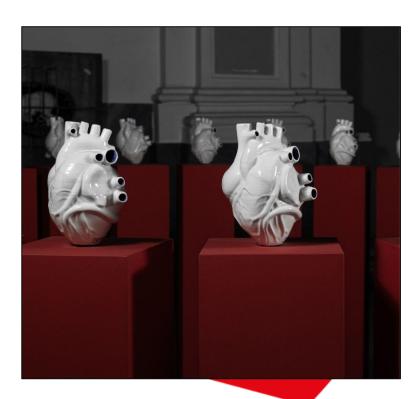


ART, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

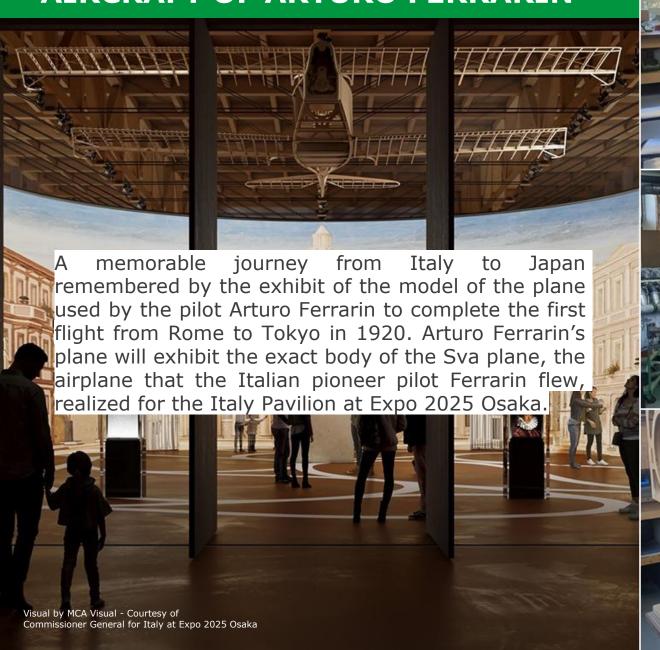


DISCOVERING RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN ITALY AND JAPAN

Il Ritratto di **Itō Mancio** (1585) by **Tintoretto**. The Italy Pavilion celebrates the deep cultural bond between Italy and Japan, presenting some iconic representations like the painting of Ito Mancio, a young nobleman who arrived from Japan to Italy with the first Tenshō Embassy (1582). The painting, realized by Tintoretto around 1585, was lent by Trivulzio Foundation.

AEROSPACE, UNDERWATER, HIGH TECHNOLOGY

At Expo 2025 Osaka, Italy showcases itself as a Nation capable of blending creativity with high technology and sustainability: from life sciences to aerospace with the Italian Space Agency, Underwater Technology with the Italian National Hub of La Spezia.

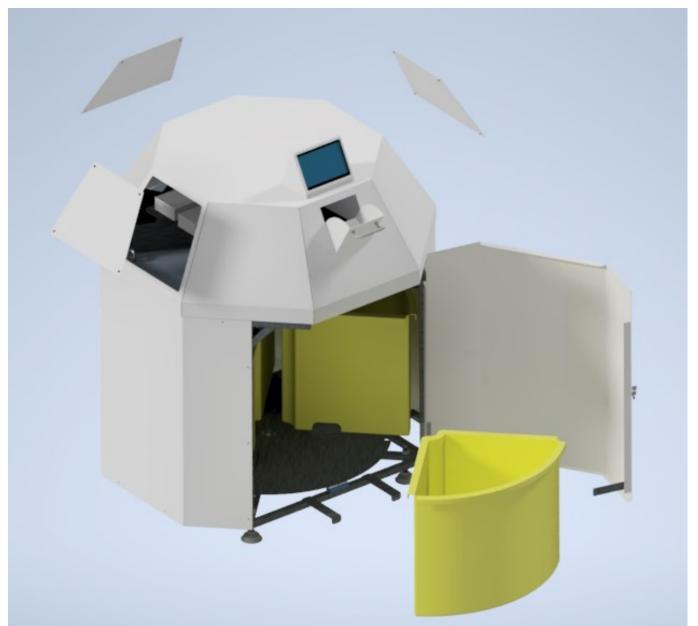


GREEN ENERGY AND GREEN STEEL

A special focus on **energy** will feature **Danieli Group**'s project on green steel, an innovative technology that not only has already revolutionized the steel industry, enabling significant energy savings, but also has a spectacular side to it: the pavilion will host a concert where for the very first time, a digital electrical furnace will be used as a musical instrument.



RECYCLING AND AI



With Ganiga's technology Italy will also promote **recycling** through an **AI-based** sorting system.

CULTURAL PROGRAM

A rich calendar of daily live performances at the Pavilion's Theatre, featuring both young talents from the top Italian Academies and historical theaters, and professional artists, will enliven aperitivo time with Italian and classical music, jazz, rock, pop and traditional Italian folk music. Special attention will be given to Italian Opera, UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage, will be featured as part of Italy's cultural program.

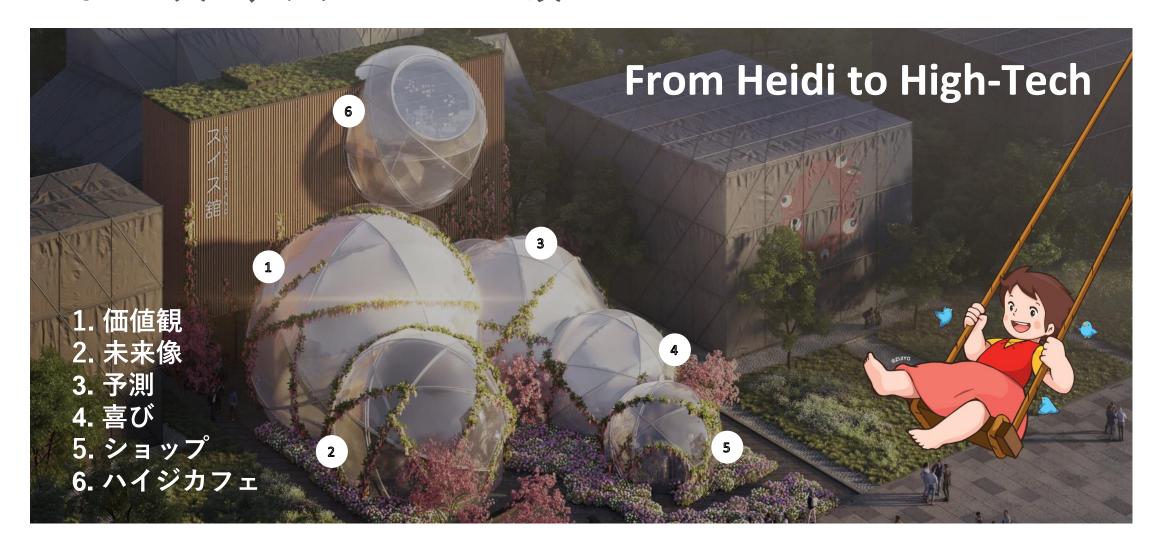

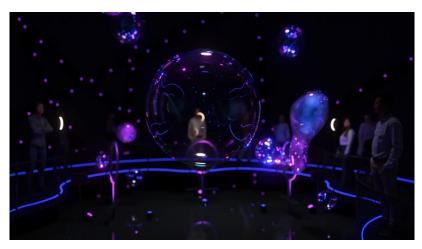

 - 13.04-04.06: "Augmented Human" (robotics, AI, Quantum, AR, VR, Collective intelligence, Digital security, Counsciousness Augmentation, Space)
 - 05-06-12.08: "Life" (Health span extension, Genetic engineering, Infectious diseases, Science diplomacy, Future of Education, Future of Economics, trade and globalization, Synthetic biology, organoids, Art&Science)
 - 13.08-13.10: "Planet" (Greentech, decarbonization, Earth system modelling, Future food systems, Space resources, Ocean stewardship, Solar radiation modification, Eco-augmentation)

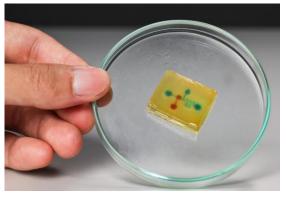
