

2-1 The Strengths of Kansai in Innovation Creation

• The Kansai region offers a wide range of potential, including large markets, convenient locations and transportation networks, diverse industries, and a well-developed business and living environment, and is well-suited for creating innovation.

(Location and Transportation Infrastructure)

- Located almost in the center of Japan, making it convenient to travel to major cities throughout the country.
- The three major cities of Osaka, Kyoto and Kobe are located adjacent to each other, and the compactness of the region means that you can get from one city to the next in as little as 30 minutes.
- Kansai International Airport is open 24 hours a day and offers many flights to Asia and many LCC flights.

[Large Economic Scale]

- Osaka is the second largest city in Japan after Tokyo, and is also the economic center of the region, with Kyoto and Kobe nearby.
- It is a huge market that accounts for about 1/5 of Japan's GDP, and is comparable to the Netherlands and Switzerland.
- The population makes up about 1/5 of the total population of Japan and is similar in size to New York City.

[Concentration of diverse industries, universities, and research institutions]

- The manufacturing industry accounts for about a quarter of the region's economy, and about 30% of the global niche top companies with high technological capabilities are concentrated here.
- The region is home to approximately 1/5 of the universities in Japan and boasts world-class universities such as Kyoto University and Osaka University.
- Due to the large number of manufacturing companies and universities in the area, the region has strengths in manufacturing, deep tech, and cutting-edge industries.

[Comprehensive Startup Support]

- There are many services available to support the growth of startups, including business exchange, pitch events, and office support.
- A wide range of support is available, from familiar and distinctive support provided by local ecosystems to support provided by regional collaboration consortiums.
- There are also many suitable locations where demonstration experiments can be conducted.

[Comfortable Business and Living Environment]

- It is cheaper than the Tokyo metropolitan area in terms of costs such as office rent and labor costs.
- With many foreign residents, Osaka is ranked in the top 10 most livable cities in the world.
- It is a region where you can enjoy a variety of attractions, including business, history, culture, and nature.
- The Kansai region has a unique culture and personality, which makes it a welcoming place for people from overseas.
- It also has geopolitical advantages such as a stable power supply and low crime rate.



2-1 The Strengths of Kansai in Innovation Creation

- Kansai is home to many global companies with advanced technological capabilities, as well as world-class universities such as Kyoto University and Osaka University.
- The region has strengths in advanced industries such as manufacturing, deep tech, and life sciences, and is also characterized by its many industry-academia collaborations and university-launched ventures.


Startups (situation of university-launched ventures))

- In FY2023, University of Tokyo continued to top the list of university-launched ventures with 420 companies. It was followed by Keio University, Kyoto University, and Osaka University.
- In terms of distribution by prefecture, Tokyo leads the way, followed by Osaka Prefecture and Kyoto Prefecture.

2-2 Startup Ecosystem Global City (Keihanshin)

• On July 14, 2020, the Osaka, Kyoto, Hyogo–Kobe Consortium was selected as a "global hub city" as part of the "World-Class Startup Ecosystem Base Formation Strategy" being promoted by the Cabinet Office (to be completed at the end of March 2025). We will leverage the strong synergy effects of national support to build a startup ecosystem that can compete on the world stage, making the most of the strengths of the Kansai region, including the area of life sciences.

By combining the strengths of the three cities (Osaka: large companies, funding, human resources; Kyoto: research seeds, product commercialization support; Kobe: social demonstration experiments, public procurement), we will focus on the fields of healthcare, manufacturing, and information and communications. Osaka University, Kyoto University, Kobe University and other universities, research institutions and companies are working together to create a support system that includes the business community and unites the Keihanshin region in preparation for the Osaka-Kansai Expo, and to create opportunities for new technologies and services.



The Microsoft AI Co-Innovation Lab (hereinafter referred to as the "Lab") is a global organization that creates innovation and is affiliated with Microsoft's headquarters in the United States. It supports the implementation and commercialization of solutions that utilize AI and other cutting-edge technologies. In October 2023, the world's sixth and Japan's first Lab opened in Kobe City.

Program overview

- The program provides an opportunity to work with Microsoft engineers to build, develop, create prototypes, and perform tests, while also confirming the potential for how Microsoft's AI and IoT products can be applied to the products and services of the participating companies and turned into a business.
- Microsoft's engineering team will work alongside the development team of participating companies to improve their skills, solve problems with applying technology, and speed up the creation of new businesses.
- In principle, anyone can use it free of charge (there are usage criteria when applying).

The Kyoto Startup Ecosystem Promotion Council was established with the participation of 46 organizations, including Kyoto Prefecture, to create an "all-Kyoto" system. Furthermore, "Kyoto Wisdom Industry Creation Center", an organization formed by the Kyoto Prefectural Government, Kyoto City, the Kyoto Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and the Kyoto Industrial Association, is the main body promoting support projects, and by creating a "co-creation space" that integrates these strengths in Kyoto, where there is a concentration of universities and research institutions and a "multilayered industrial structure" based on a variety of technological seeds, a startup ecosystem is being formed.

3-4 Startup Visa

• Foreign entrepreneurs can submit a business preparation activity plan to a "Foreign Entrepreneurship Promotion Organization," and if the organization deems that the applicant meets the requirements and the Immigration Bureau approves the application, the applicant will be granted a "Designated Activities" visa which allows a maximum stay of two years in Japan.

*Typically, in order for a foreign national who wishes to start a business to be granted the status of residence of "Business Manager," they must meet certain requirements such as securing a place of business and investing at least 5 million yen or employing two or more full-time employees at the time of application to the Immigration Bureau.

3-5 **Digital Nomad visa**

• Those eligible for this system are foreign nationals who work in Japan using information and communication technology through an employment contract with a foreign company or organization, and are expected to include IT/software developers, digital designers, online secretaries, and sole proprietors who manage the business of foreign companies.

"Designated Activities (for Digital Nomad)" (6months)

- * Cannot extend period of stay.
- * Residence card will not be issued.

Requirements

- 1. The period of stay in Japan with status of residence of "Designated Activities (for Digital Nomad)" must not exceed 6 months within a year.
- 2. Applicant must be nationals or citizens of countries/regions which are under the scope of the visa exemption arrangements (Temporary Visitor) and also subjected to Japan's Tax Conventions.
- 3. Annual income of an applicant must be at least 10 million yen at the time of application.
- 4. Applicant must hold a private medical travel insurance which covers death, injury, illness during their stay.
 - * The amount of compensation for medical treatment for injury and illness must be 10 million yen or more.

Authorized activities

Activities that involve using information and communication technology in Japan to engage in business of the organization's business office located in a foreign country, based on an employment contract with a corporation or other foreign organization established in accordance with the laws and regulations of a foreign country

OR

- Activities that involve providing services for a fee or selling goods, etc, to persons located in a communication technology
- * Activities excluded that cannot be provided or sold without entering Japan.
- * Under this status of residence, it is not permitted to work based on an employment contract, with a Japanese public or private organization.
- * In principle, it is not granted to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence previously granted.







Spouse or child of Digital Nomad

Spouse or child to be supported are granted a status of residence of "Designated Activities" (for spouse or child of Digital Nomad) and can accompany Digital Nomad.

- * Applicant must be nationals or citizens of which are under the scope of the visa exemption arrangements (Temporary Visitor) and satisfy 4 above.
- * In principle, it is not granted to engage in activity other than that permitted under the status of residence previously granted.

Reasons for expanding into Kansai?

We also received guidance on how to connect with administrative scriveners and tax accountant. Given our limited resources and lack of local connections, the support we received with procedures and other practical matters was essential for us.

When establishing a base, I believe there are **two key factors** to consider: The first is determining whether the region is "suitable for your business". The second is assessing whether the "the local temperament and culture align with the entrepreneur's lifestyle", which is just as important as the business considerations.


